# **School Supplies**

Teachers will let students know what materials they will need for each class during the first week of school. A good starting point is to have loose-leaf paper, binders, folders, pencils, and pens that will help with the initial days of school. It is also suggested that students purchase some type of agenda that they may use to keep track of their assignments. The school will not be providing agendas to students. #### **Computer Bags**

For the 2018-19 school year, the district will no longer provide students with a computer bag. Students will need to provide their own "messenger" style bag. At the end of the 2017-18 school year, all 9th, 10th, and 11th graders were given their district issued computer bag and they may continue to use those bags; however, the district will no longer provide repairs for them. We will have a limited supply of bags available for purchase at the beginning of the year. Students will not be issued a computer unless they have a computer bag. On the Civic Memorial High School website, we have links to Amazon and Walmart of approved bags. It **must be a messenger style bag** that is designed to fit an 11.6 - 12-inch laptop computer. #### **Express Sign Out**

Does your student need to leave early? If so, we can help make this a quick and convenient process! Just send a note with your student and have them drop it off in the main office before school and we will have your student in the office waiting to leave when you show up to school. Please remember to bring your drivers license when signing out your student.

#### **CM Open House**

We will hold our annual Open House on <u>August 16, 2018 from</u> 6:00 PM until 7:00 PM. During this event, you will have an opportunity to meet your student's teachers. Following open house, we will have a parent information seminar entitled, "Drug Awareness and Protecting Your Child" at 7:00 PM in the CMHS auditorium.

#### **Bell Schedule Update**

Students at C.M.H.S. will have the opportunity to continue to enjoy the benefits of having a modified block schedule. However, some minor changes have been made to the schedule. Students will start at 8:00 AM with a 2:34 PM release Monday thru Friday. On block days (Wednesdays and Thursdays), students will be assigned to a study hall period for the last 30 minutes of the day. Students will NOT have to attend the study hall if they meet the following criteria:

- 5 or fewer absences
- C or better in all classes
- No more that 2 disciplinary points

Students must sign in their study hall room before leaving the building. Those wishing to leave during study hall must provide their own transportation.

## Attendance Information

If it is necessary for your student to miss part of a day, please keep the following in mind. For purposes of determining daily attendance, which is the basis of a large part of school funding, the state has the following guidelines:

- A student may be considered present all day if he/she misses 51 minutes or less of the school day.
- If a student misses 51 to 149 minutes he/she is considered to be absent half a day. More than 149 minutes is considered a full day.
- Personal illness, serious illness in the family, or other circumstances making attendance or punctuality extremely difficult will be the only
  legitimate excuse for absences or tardiness. Oversleeping and car trouble are considered unexcused.
- If a parent calls on the day of the absence, it is not necessary for the student to bring a written excuse. If a parent does not call on the day of the absence, a note from the parent detailing the reason for the absence is required. This note must be presented when the student returns.

  An absence that has not been excused five (5) days after a student returns will remain classified as unexcused.
- If you know that your student must leave during the day for an appointment, please send a note with your child in the morning so he/she can get a pass and we don't have to interrupt the classroom. Students must have a pass to get out of class.
- If students feel ill during the school day they are to go to the nurse and she will notify the parents. Students are not to use their cell phones to call their parents. If students must leave during the day, they must sign out in the main office. Leaving without permission will constitute truancy.
- Once a student has missed five days of school in a given semester, all other absences after the fifth one will require a written physician's
  excuse for each absence to be excused.
  - A student who misses more than 12 days per semester can have credit for that course withheld. A student who has missed 12 days or more can reclaim a day of attendance by attending two sessions of Friday Night School.
